


Students cooperated with the programme and executed the postures well.

Divas in Defence: Self Defence classes for Girls




Blood Donation Camp


Republic Day Celebration


Anemia Campaign - June 12


Awareness Programme on POCSO-June 22








Gender Awareness Training Programme - September 20


Disha 2021- Seven Days Special Camp - December 26 to January 01, 2022

<u>Eraar Punarjani: Puzhaye Ariyaan – Clean River Proclamation Rally – February 25</u>


